Semantic Markup vs. Formal Markup

- Semantics is the study of meaning
- Thus, semantic markup is markup which emphasizes the meaning of the content rather than its appearance
- However, semantic elements have a default appearance, that may differ from plain text
- Formal markup is the term used for markup which infers only the presentational aspect of content

Why Use Semantic Markup?

- Semantic markup facilitates machine readability meaning browsers and search engines will be better able to interpret content. Example – <u>page outliner</u>
- Semantic content is easier to restyle and reset and in the best situations it sets itself

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 - The <dfn> element identifies a term to be defined
 - The "title" attribute may be used to indicate the full meaning of the term
 - The title may be displayed under certain circumstances, such as mouse hover

In a November 2009 interview, Monáe revealed the title and concept behind her album, *The ArchAndroid*. The album was released on May 18, 2010. The second and third suites of *Metropolis* are combined into this full-length release, in which Monáe's alter-ego, Cindi Mayweather—also the protagonist of *Metropolis*: *The Chase Suite*—becomes a messianic

- The <cite> element identifies the name of a work – a book, film, song, poem, sculpture, etc.
- Cite should not be used to identify names of individuals

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<cite>The Audition</cite>

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- <samp> elements indicate sample output form a computer program
- <kbd> is used to identify keyboard input

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In Windows XP, pressing Control, Alt, and Delete at the same time, will bring up the task manager.

<kbd>Control</kbd>, <kbd>Alt</kbd>, and <kbd>Delete</kbd>

- elements indicate content that has been revised out of the document
- <ins> elements indicate content to be revised into a document

- The "cite" attribute may be used to reference a reason for the change
- The cite attribute value must be a valid URI

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¹⁾a uniform resource identifier (URI) is a <u>string</u> of <u>characters</u> used to <u>identify</u> a name or a <u>resource</u>. Such identification enables interaction with representations of the resource over a network. URIs can be classified as locators (URLs), as names (URNs), or as both. A <u>uniform resource name</u> (URN) functions like a person's name, while a <u>uniform resource locator</u> (URL) resembles that person's street address. In other words: the URN defines an item's identity, while the URL provides a method for finding it.

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

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
