Lab 5 (5 points)

In this lab, you should finish the design of your page

- 1. Add an internal navigation section to your document
 - a. Use "id" attributes to anchor parts of your page
 - b. Use <a> elements to link to the anchors
 - c. Hint: the heading elements are a good place to anchor
- 2. Remember that images are inline elements, make sure at least one of your images is placed as part of your regular text flow (that is, inside a paragraph)
 - a. Use the float and width properties to properly display the image
 - b. Make sure that your floating elements do not "cling" to the surrounding text
- 3. If your webpage does not use a centered layout, make a copy of your work and create a centered layout
 - a. Do not change the width of the "body" or "html" elements
 - b. Make proper use of <div> and elements, as well as the class selector
